

Glasgow City Charter approved etc.

4 With reference to the minutes of 2nd November 2017 (Print 4, page 384) approving in principle the draft City Charter and agreeing that further consultation should take place to inform the development of the finalised Charter, Councillor Layden, City Convener for Equalities and Human Rights, presented a report providing a summary of the main findings from the consultation and an updated version of the Charter, advising

- (1) of the consultation process and a summary of the main findings;
- (2) that the City Charter would form part of the Council's engagement with communities and businesses in delivering the Council Strategic Plan supported by a communication plan and strategy; and
- (3) that the communication plan would also look at rolling the Charter out across the city and the opportunities for community groups and neighbourhoods to sign up to the Charter and demonstrate how they were working with the Council to improve their local area.

After consideration, the Council

- (a) noted the outcome of the consultation;
- (b) approved the revised City Charter; and
- (c) agreed that
 - (i) the Wellbeing, Empowerment, Community and Citizen Engagement City Policy Committee would be consulted on establishing annual performance metrics;
 - (ii) performance against the Charter would be reported annually in the Annual Performance Report beginning in 2018/19; and
 - (iii) an independent report on the effectiveness of the Charter would be undertaken in 2021.
