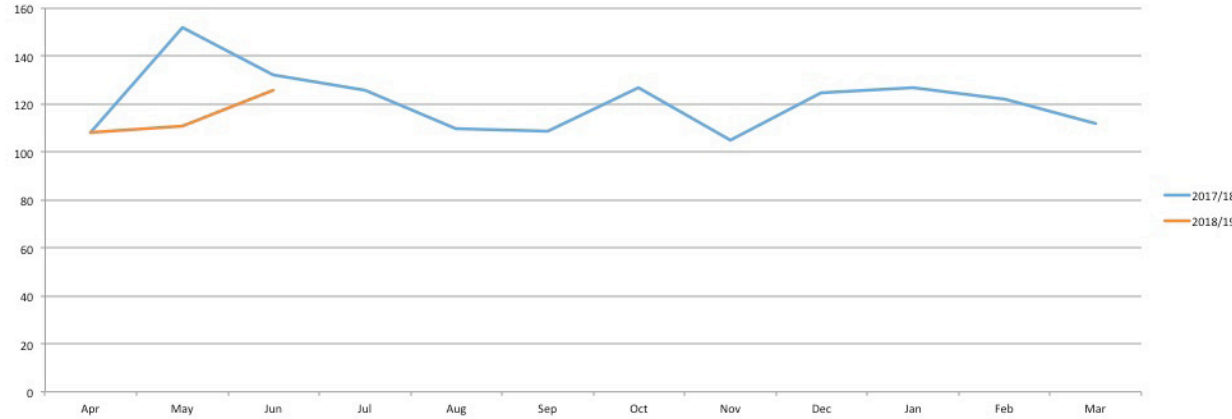

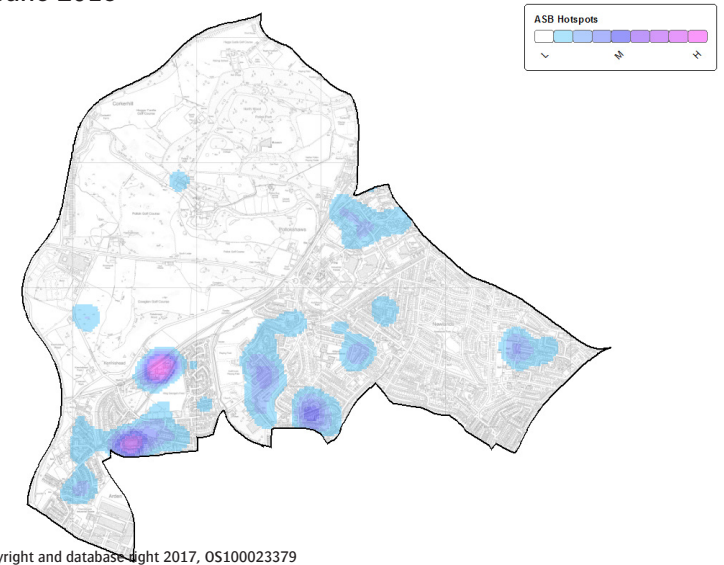

Level of antisocial behaviour incidents 2017-18 v 2018-19

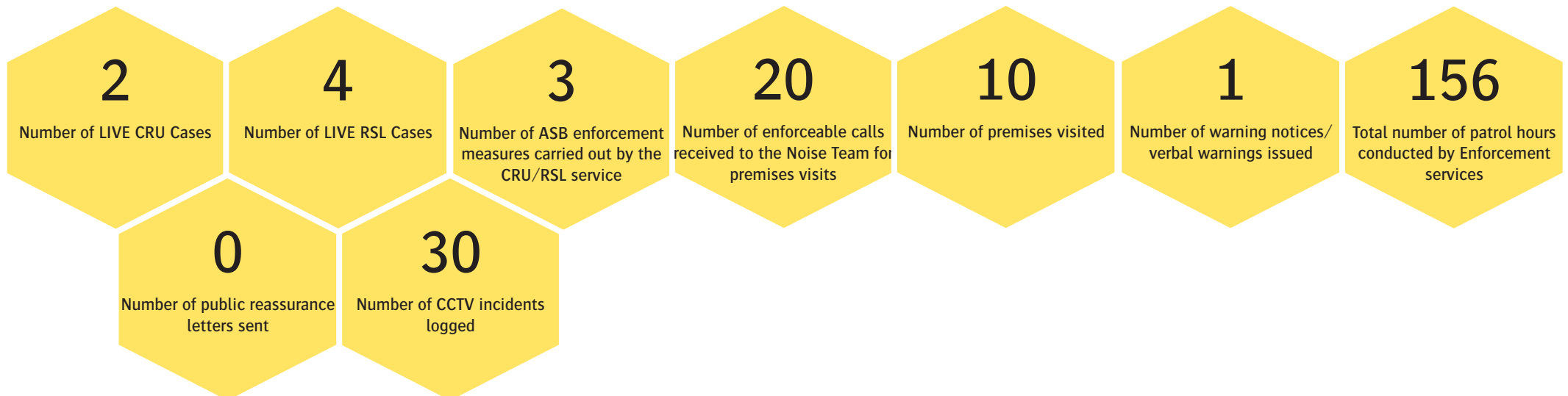


Geographical distribution of Antisocial Behaviour Incidents April - June 2018

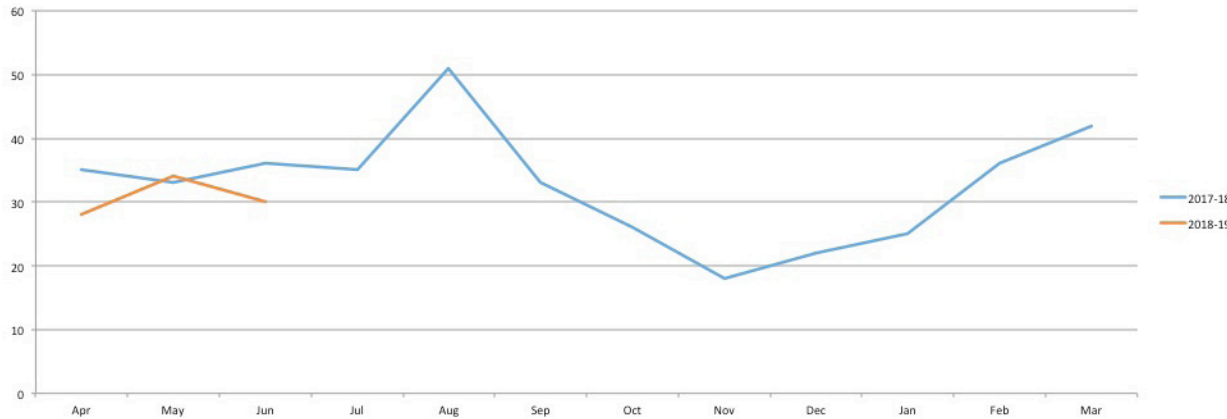

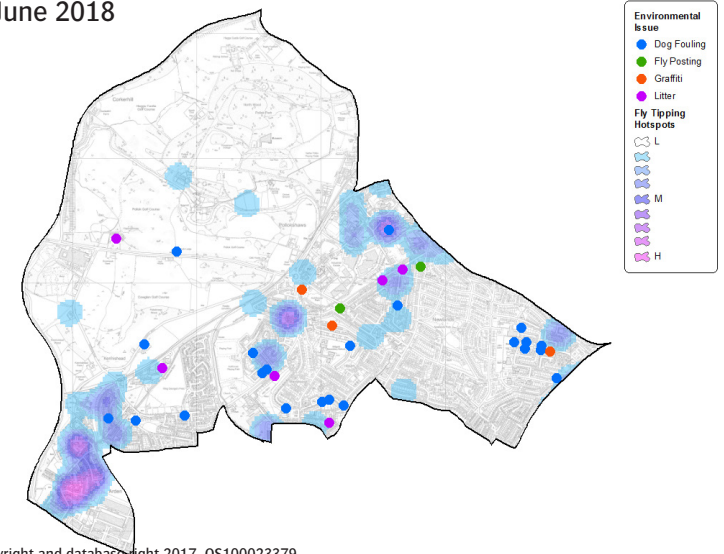

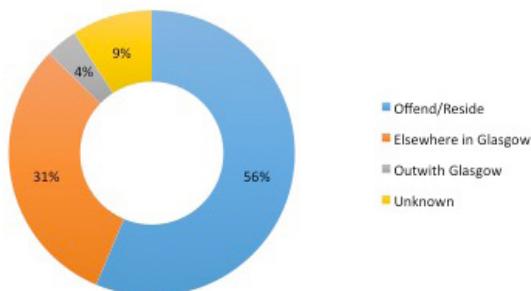

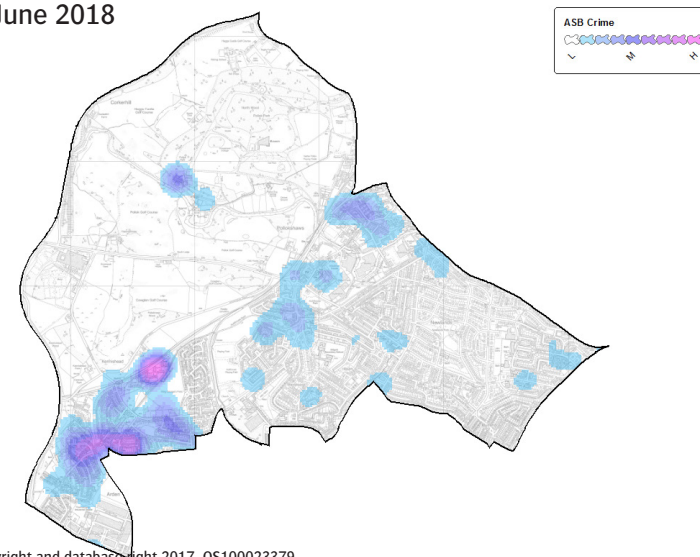

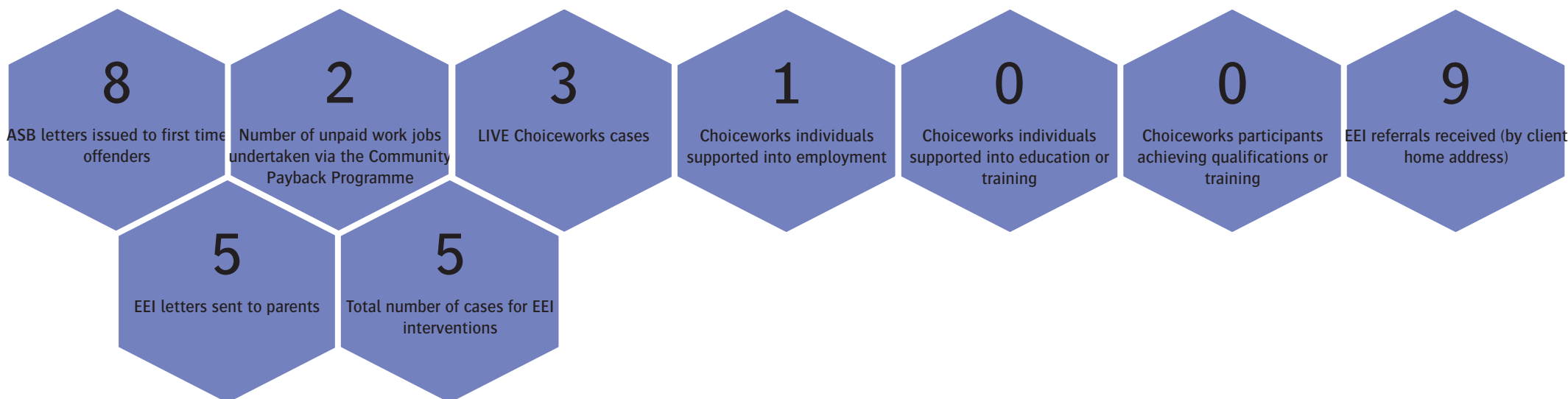
Geographical distribution of ASB offences April - June 2018

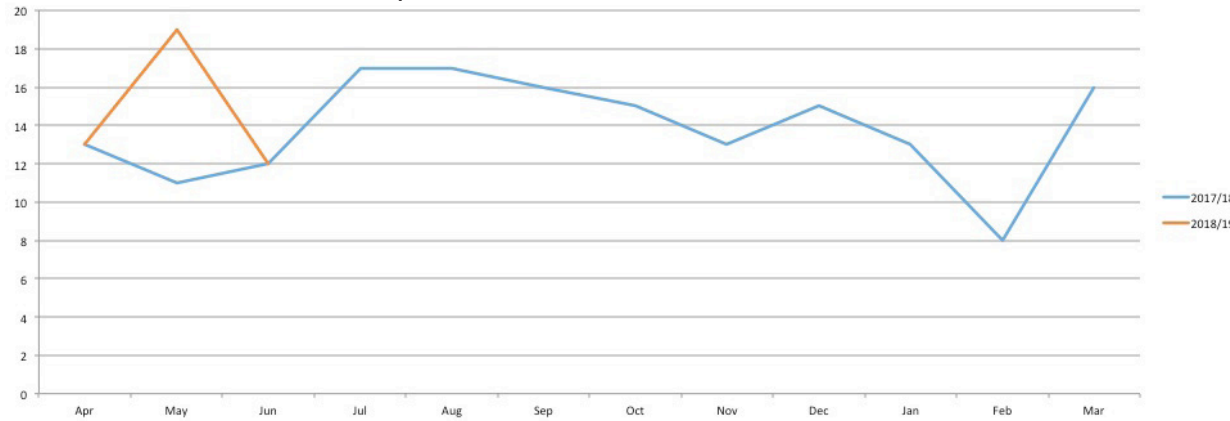

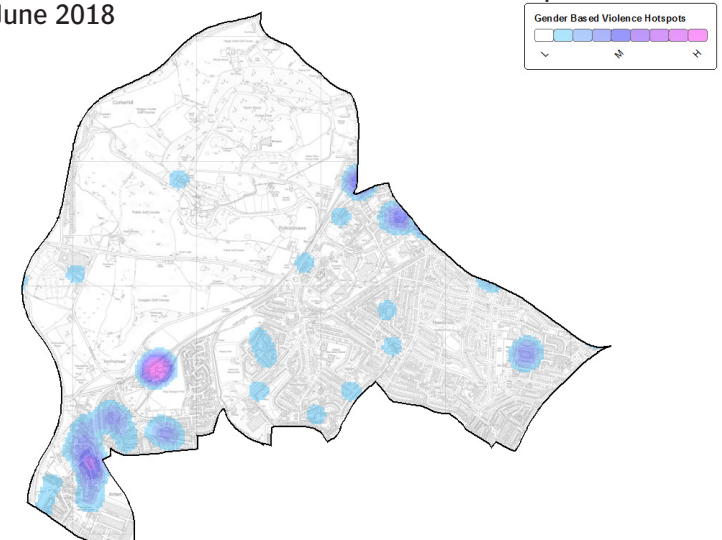
Domestic Abuse Profile

Level of domestic abuse crime reports 2017-18 v 2018-19



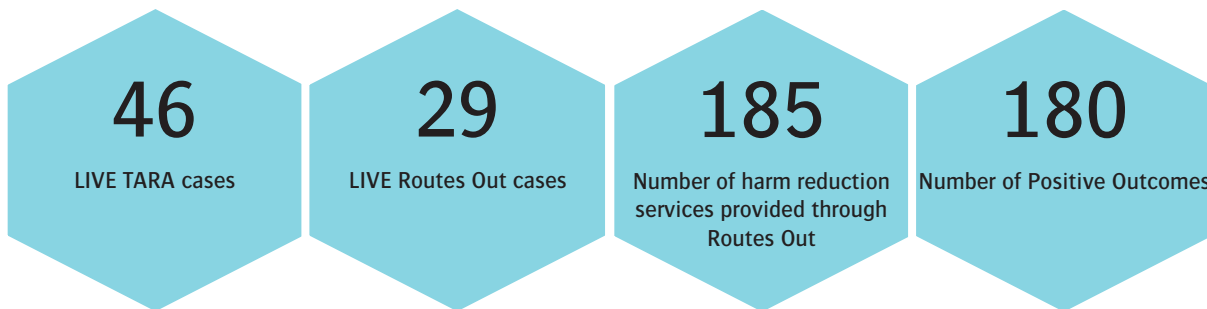
Geographical distribution of domestic abuse crime reports April - June 2018
