Minutes of previous meeting approved.

1 The minutes of the previous meeting of 18th September 2024 were submitted and approved.

Festive Lighting 2024/25 update noted – Funding approved.

- With reference to the minutes of 18th September 2024, there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability (NRS), regarding festive lighting within the Ward, advising of
- (1) the central funding of £3,600 available to meet the costs of erecting and maintaining festive lighting and the proposed costs and locations;
- (2) the new pricing guidelines for the 2024/25 festive lighting programme; and
- (3) the festive lighting programme delivered in the Ward for 2023/24.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the lighting arrangements and central funding available for the 2024/25 programme;
- (b) approved funding for festive lighting at the following locations:-

- (i) Nitshill Road/Parkhouse Road;
- (ii) Peat Road roundabout/Barrhead Road; and
- (iii) Braidcraft Road at the Co-op, at a total cost of £6,330 for all locations; and
- (c) agreed that NRS would liaise with the Partnership members to arrange a site visit for the tree location at Peat Road roundabout/Barrhead Road.
