

Findings from the Health and Wellbeing survey noted.

6 There was submitted a presentation by John Casey, South Health Improvement Team, Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership, regarding the findings from the Adult Health and Wellbeing 2022/23 survey, advising

- (1) that the survey provided valuable information on the self-perceived health and wellbeing of residents, health behaviours, social health, social capital and financial wellbeing and had been conducted at 3-yearly intervals since 1999;
- (2) of the survey content and reporting format, as detailed in the report;
- (3) of the aim to continue to highlight and discuss the survey results through all the networks including a city-wide Third Sector information event; and
- (4) that information from the survey would help to inform its actions.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report; and
- (b) raised a number of questions and concerns that were addressed by John Casey.
