Police Scotland ward update noted – Request to Police Scotland.

- **6** There was heard a report by Chief Inspector Nigel Thacker, Police Scotland, advising
- (1) of the action plan in place over the previous 2 months, with more officers visible on patrol;
- (2) of the drug offences detected within the ward;
- (3) that road traffic offenders would be targeted, focusing on drink/drug drivers, drivers with no licence etc to prevent road traffic accidents;
- (4) that there had been no issues on Bonfire night, no house break-ins reported and no car thefts:
- (5) that the results of the first user satisfaction survey had been released, with Greater Glasgow scoring 72% satisfaction;
- (6) of the North East Violence Prevention Partnership meetings which aimed to reduce violence, which had been attended by a number of organisations; and
- (7) of the youth programme, in conjunction with the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service and the Scottish Ambulance Service.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report and thanked Chief Inspector Thacker for the work carried out in the ward by Police Scotland; and
- (b) requested that the Elected Members be more involved with the North East Violence Prevention Partnership, with notices of meetings sent to members along with a copy of the minutes for reference.
