Conditions:

- 1. Suitable provisions should be made for variances in ground conditions.
- 2. Stalls or lightweight structures to be suitably fixed down to prevent uplift due to wind loadings.
- 3. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.

The market will consist of a mix of 35 food and craft stalls with a capacity of 300 persons
