1. Area Budget allocations 2024/25

Glasgow City Council agreed its budget for 2024/25 on 15 February 2024 with the overall funding available for Area Partnerships maintained at 2023/24 levels. The City Administration Committee approved allocations to Area Partnerships on 21 March 2024. The Pollokshields Area Budget for 2024/25 was £62,408.19.
