

## Area Budget 2025/26 – Application for funding dealt with etc.

7 With reference to the minutes of the Council's City Administration Committee of 13th March 2025 (Print 7, page 31), when the committee approved the 2025/26 Area Budget allocations, there was submitted a report by the Head of Policy and Corporate Governance, advising

- (1) of the current position in relation to the Area Partnership's budget for 2025/26;
- (2) that the Baillieston Area Partnership's budget allocation for 2025/26 was £63,838 and a total of £5,317 had been allocated to date, leaving a balance of £58,521; and
- (3) of the applications for funding from the Area Budget 2025/26.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the
  - (i) position regarding the Area Budget allocation for 2025/26; and
  - (ii) 3 applications dealt with under the delegated functions and an application by Create Your Dream that was ineligible for funding, as detailed in the report; and
- (b) dealt with applications for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:

Education Services – Garrowhill Primary School	Towards the cost of purchasing resources in order to run the Play Along Maths programme with P1 pupils and parents	Awarded £1,340
Education Services – Swinton Primary School	Towards the cost of developing the playground to include 2 mini reading teepees to provide pupils who wished to read with a quiet area outdoors and to expand the existing trim trail to include a wobble board	Awarded £2,700
Loop Theatre	Towards the cost of providing a 24-week theatre programme for 15 residents at Bealach House	Awarded £6,240
