Introduction

- 1. This report provides details on the Area Partnership's budget position for 2024/25.
- Glasgow City Council agreed its budget for 2024/25 on 15th February 2024 with the overall funding available for Area Partnerships maintained at 2023/24 levels. The City Administration Committee approved allocations to Area Partnerships on 21st March 2024. The Calton Area Budget for 2024/25 is £99,512.15

Area Budget Expenditure to Date

- 3. The Area Partnership committed £4,060.25 from the 2024/25 Area Budget at its last meeting on 5th February 2025.
- 4. Therefore, a total of £98,126.97 (98.61%) has been committed to various projects serving the Calton Ward area, leaving a balance of £1,385.18.
- 5. A copy of the Calton 2024/25 Area Budget Monitoring Statement is attached as Appendix 1 and provides a breakdown of funds allocated from the 2024/25 Area Budget
