Festive Lighting 2025/26 update noted – Request to Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability.

- There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability (NRS), regarding Festive Lighting within the Ward, advising of the central funding of £3,600 available to meet the costs of erecting and maintaining festive lighting and the proposed costs and locations advising
- (1) of the 2024/25 festive displays and switch-on events and asked the Partnership to confirm whether these should be included in the 2025/26 programme;
- (2) of the standard pricing schedule for the 2024-2028 festive lighting programme following the procurement exercise carried out to deliver the programme; and
- (3) that approved funding in excess of the central funding would be met by Drumchapel/Anniesland Area Partnership from other funds.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the lighting arrangements and the central funding available for the 2025/26 programme;
- (b) approved additional funding of £4,290 over and above the central funding; and
- (c) requested NRS provide
 - (i) an extra set of lights on the tree located at Great Western Road/Baldwin Avenue:
 - (ii) an extra set of lights on the tree located at Hecla Park;
 - (iii) an extra set of lights on the tree located at Kirkhope Roundabout; and
 - (iv) a planted/restricted growth tree at Kirkhope Roundabout.
