Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 Election of Vice-Convener

Purpose of Report:

For Members to consider electing a Vice-Convener of the Licensing Board.

Background:

While there is no legal requirement for a Vice-Convener within the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, historically the Licensing Board has always elected a Vice-Convener. The process for electing a Vice-Convener has followed the same process as election of Convener.

The Licensing Board should therefore, at the first meeting after a vacancy arises, elect one of its members to fill the vacancy.

Recommendations:

Members are asked to:

- (a) elect a Vice-Convener;
- (b) instruct the Depute Clerk to give notice to Glasgow City Council of the election of a Vice-Convener.
