Agenda Item 2	Authority to negotiate an excambion of sites at Lochend Road and Baldragon Road (Ward 21)	
Question 1 by Councillor Andrew	Regarding the protected status of water voles, given the previous care taken not to reveal the whereabouts of the vole population has this paper not now revealed their proposed location and is this no longer an issue of keeping their location under wraps.	
Answer	There is no requirement to keep the location of sites that have water vole populations confidential. We do keep sites for some protected species confidential to reduce any risk of persecution. The main are of caution regarding water voles is to make sure we don't say that sites do not have water voles without first carrying out a survey using an experienced member of staff or consultant. For all grassland sites within the water vole trigger map area we need to acknowledge that water vole may be present until a full survey shows otherwise. We also need to be clear that water voles are quite mobile, and can quickly colonise sites that are suitable. This is why we advise that grass is kept short through regular maintenance for sites where we don't want a risk that water voles will move in.
