Langside Area Budget 2024/25:

Applications For Funding

Purpose of Report:

To provide the Area Partnership with details of the current position of the 2024/25 Area Budget and make recommendations on further applications for funding.

Introduction.

1. This report provides details on the Area Partnership's budget position for 2024/25; applications considered under Delegated Functions; and makes recommendations on further funding applications.

Background.

2. Glasgow City Council agreed its budget for 2024/25 on 15th February 2024 with the overall funding available for Area Partnerships maintained at 2023/24 levels. At its meeting on 21st March 2024, the Council's City Administration Committee approved funding allocations for each Area Partnership. The Langside Area Budget for 2024/25 is **£61,580.48**.
