

Suggested Conditions

01. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun no later than the expiration of three years beginning with the date of grant of this permission.

Reason: In the interest of certainty and the proper planning of the area, and to comply with section 58 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, as amended.

02. Before any work on the site is begun, details of refuse and recycling storage areas and bins shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the planning authority. These facilities shall be completed before the development/the relevant part of the development is occupied.

Reason: To ensure the proper disposal of waste and to safeguard the environment of the development.

03. Provision shall be made within the development for a minimum of 1 cycle parking space. This provision shall be in accordance with the requirements of Glasgow City Council's City Development Plan, Supplementary Guidance 11: Sustainable Transport, Section 4 Cycle Parking. The cycle parking shall be available for use in accordance with the approved drawings before the development is occupied.

Reason: To ensure that cycle parking is available for the occupiers/users of the development.

Advisory Notes:

1. The developer should advise each prospective purchaser that residents may not be eligible to purchase a resident's on-road parking permit if such permits are introduced in line with Glasgow City Council policy.
