Greater Easterhouse Strategic Development Framework and Drumchapel Local Development Framework (Wards 14, 18, 20 and 21) – Action programme delivery 2024/25 noted.

- There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding an update on delivery of the 2024/25 action programme for the Greater Easterhouse Strategic Development Framework (SDF) and the Drumchapel Local Development Framework (LDF) (Wards 14, 18, 20 and 21), advising
- (1) that the Greater Easterhouse SDF had been adopted as supplementary guidance to the City Development Plan in November 2024 and the Drumchapel LDF had been adopted as supplementary guidance to the City Development Plan in June 2024, making a total adoption of 9 SDFs which set out the long-term spatial vision for each area and were used to direct investment decisions and inform new development;
- (2) that the Greater Easterhouse SDF aimed to co-ordinate investment and action to significantly improve the urban form and economic vitality of the north of the city over the long term and to achieve the vision for the North East to become a healthy, high quality and sustainable place in which to live, work and visit;
- (3) of the delivery of the 2024/25 Greater Easterhouse SDF action programme and its priorities for 2026; and
- (4) of the delivery of the 2024/25 Drumchapel LDF action programme and its priorities for 2026.

After consideration, the committee noted the annual progress for the delivery of the Greater Easterhouse Strategic Development Framework and the Drumchapel Local Development Framework and their priorities for 2025/26.
