Local Parks and Open Spaces Update

Purpose of Report:

To provide the Area Partnership with an update on the Local Parks and Open Space Fund.

Recommendations:

The Area Partnership is asked to note this report and approve the recommendation that sums of £4800 and £7200 previously allocated to new finger signage to be reallocated towards Knightswood Park Food Hub

1. Introduction and progress to date

- 1.1 Glasgow City Council allocated £3 million to Area Partnerships across the city for investment in Parks and Open Spaces over 2021/22 & 2022/23. This report is to provide members an update on each allocated project within the ward and to advise on any further steps to be taken.
- 1.2 It should be noted that 328 projects have been approved on an ongoing basis since year 1 of this fund. Whilst the Service is placing focus on delivering these within desired timescales, these will be subject to resource pressures within the Service, alongside daily operational requirements. Where possible, the Service has been engaging with partners to grant award monies for project delivery where appropriate, to support community empowerment and local capacity building.

2. Parks and Open Spaces Fund

2.1 The following table provides updates to approved projects from 21/22 and 22/23.

Knightswood Park	Paladin Avenue - New access point proposed into park which would provide access the towpath, schools and Great Western Road. New entrance added to railings, and new 30m section of tarmac footpath, and associated vegetation management and new tree planting	£10,000	Complete

Clyde Walkway near Ellerslie Path	Planting works to 220m long stretch of embankment to improve biodiversity and colour.	£18,400	Complete
Knightswood	Contribution towards a wider funding package and will form the subject of further engagement with Friends of Knightswood Park and local food groups in relation to deliver a Food Hub to include growing, food distribution and addressing food poverty.	£50,000	Preliminary feasibility works underway to support ongoing engagement with statutory bodies and Glasgow Family
Yoker Cycle Path	Additional phase of new finger signage at to promote active travel, with additional 6 locations to build on the locations put forward within 2021/22 by the Glasgow Eco Trust	£7200	Recommend reallocation towards Knightswood Park Food Hub
