Recommendation:

The Committee may grant the licence.

Conditions:

1. Section 89 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 approval for any structure 600mm and greater above ground level is required.
2. Wherever possible cable runs and water supply pipes should be contained out-with the public access areas and/or contained within proprietary ducting.
3. An appropriate event management plan and risk assessments must be provided
4. A system of wind/weather management will required for the event and should include all relevant structures.
5. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.
6. A final inspection is required prior to the release of the licence
