Recommendation:

The Committee may grant the licence.

Conditions:

- 1. Section 89 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 approval for any structure 600mm and greater above ground level is required.
- 2. Wherever possible cable runs and water supply pipes should be contained out-with the public access areas and/or contained within proprietary ducting.
- 3. An appropriate event management plan and risk assessments must be provided
- 4. A system of wind/weather management will required for the event and should include all relevant structures.
- 5. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.
- 6. A final inspection is required prior to the release of the licence

The proposed capacity for the event is 4200 persons.
