

### **Scottish Fire and Rescue Service Ward update noted.**

**3** There was heard and noted a report by Station Commander John Allan, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, regarding the current issues, incidents and work being carried out in the Ward for Quarter 4, from 1st January to 31st March 2026, advising the Partnership

- (1) that the service had attended 712 incidents in the North-East area, these being 193 fires, 122 non-fire incidents, 322 false alarms and 2 non fire fatalities;
- (2) a new reporting mechanism had been developed that would break statistics down so that they are more ward specific;
- (3) there had been no significant fire related incidents in the Dennistoun Ward, with no fatalities or casualties; and
- (4) that there had been 4 road traffic collisions in the ward, 2 of which resulted in 3 hospital casualties.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report and thanked Station Commander Allan for the update; and
- (b) raised a series of questions and concerns regarding the selling of vapes and the disposal of batteries which were addressed by Station Commander Allan.
