

Land at Daldowie (Ward 20) - Authority to Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability to commence negotiations for an off-market letting approved.

4 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability seeking authority to commence off market negotiations with Scottish Water for the sale of the land at Daldowie (Ward 20) advising,

- (1) that Glasgow City Council (GCC) owned the entire subject site detailed in the appendix to the report and in addition to the training centre, there was two semi-detached residential houses known as 1 and 2 that were both occupied by tenants under residential leases;
- (2) that Scottish Water had identified the site as its preferred location for a new multi-million-pound project which would create a new waste treatment facility that would be a major upgrade to the existing sewage treatment facilities, providing environmental benefits, improved efficiency, reducing operating costs and would treat waste to a higher standard; and
- (3) of the proposal, as detailed in the report.

Councillor Kelly, seconded by Councillor Scally moved that authority be granted to the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability to commence negotiations with Scottish Water for the sale of land at Daldowie (Ward 20).

Bailie Lalley, seconded by Councillor Mooney moved as an amendment that consideration be continued to a future meeting to allow for further information.

On a vote being taken by calling the roll, 6 members voted for the amendment and 5 for the motion. The amendment was accordingly declared to be carried.
