

## **Pride in Place Programme – Update noted.**

**11** There was heard and noted a report by the Head of Policy and Corporate Governance advising that

- (1) the Pride in Place Programme was a UK Government investment programme designed to empower communities to shape their place and support transformational change at a neighbourhood level;
- (2) each community would receive funding and support totalling up to £20million, with funding being split 63% capital and 37% revenue and that funding would be paid to Local Authorities over a 10 year period;
- (3) after an initial 'capacity payment' in early 2026, Neighbourhood Boards could spend their revenue funding allocation flexibly across the lifespan of the programme, however, in the early years of the programme, this should be used to build capacity locally and undertake extensive community engagement;
- (4) in February 2026, it had been confirmed that Castlemilk and Sighthill/Springburn had been selected to be part of phase 2 of the Pride in Place programme;
- (5) upon Chairs being identified, Neighbourhood Boards would be formed and would comprise of residents, community groups, businesses, elected members and MPs; and
- (6) the Area Partnership would receive updates on progress as the programme developed.
