### Street Trader's Licence conditions referred to:

#### Condition 13

Where the licence allows the holder to sell from a vehicle, kiosk or moveable stall at an approved stance, the vehicle, kiosk or moveable stall shall be capable of being speedily and easily removed. At the end of any period of trading, the licenceholder shall immediately remove the vehicle, kiosk or moveable stall from the approved stance.
