**Neighbourhood Infrastructure Improvement Fund (NIIF) – New Proposal**

**Purpose of Report:**

There are current proposals in the system for CCTV to be installed at John Knox/Wishart entrance to the Necropolis which would again extend the CCTV network coverage of that whole section.</p>	<p>Duke Street/John Knox Street</p>
