

Glasgow's Climate Plan 2026 - 2030 approved.

4 With reference to the minutes of Net Zero and Climate Progress Monitoring City Policy Committee of 14th April 2026 (page 000 hereof) recommending approval of Glasgow's Climate Plan 2026-2030, Councillor Millar, City Convener for Climate, Glasgow Green Deal, Transport and City Centre Recovery, presented a report on the matter,

- (1) advising
 - (a) that Glasgow's Climate Plan represented a city-wide approach to address the Climate and Ecological Emergency and included a target for the city to achieve net zero carbon emissions by 2030;
 - (b) of the main themes that had emerged following the formal consultation that had been conducted between 11th December 2025 and 15th February 2026, following approval by this committee on 4th December 2025 (Print 6, page 93), which had been incorporated into the revised Plan; and
 - (c) of the new actions that had been developed as a result of the consultation, as detailed in the report; and
- (2) detailing in the appendices to the report, the Consultation questions, the redrafted Glasgow's Climate Plan 2026 – 2030 and the detailed Climate Action Plan.

After consideration, the committee approved Glasgow's Climate Plan 2026 – 2030 for publication.
