

Scottish Fire and Rescue Services ward update notes ect.

4 There was submitted a report by Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, advising the Partnership of the incidents that had taken place in the Victoria Park Ward over the last quarter, advising

- (1) that there had been 3 accidental dwelling fires, 2 non-fire casualties, 2 deliberate fires, 15 unwanted fire alarm signals, 1 road traffic collision and 26 home fire safety visits carried out;
- (2) of the new tri service first Police, Ambulance and Fire Service initiative (PAFS) aimed at youth engagement which had been held in Calton, Easterhouse and Pollock fire stations to experience emergency services and the plans to role this out further; and
- (3) that the Fire at Union Street is currently under investigation and that they will bring back more information to the Partnership when the investigation is complete.

After consideration, the partnership

- (a) noted the report; and
- (b) expressed concerns around BBQ's in parks to which was responded to by Station Commander Kenneth MacSwan.
