

Suggested Conditions

01. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun no later than the expiration of three years beginning with the date of grant of this permission.

Reason: In the interest of certainty and the proper planning of the area, and to comply with section 58 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, as amended.

02. All external fittings including ventilation plant, ducts and grilles, balanced flues and security fittings shall be factory finished or painted out to match the colour of the background to which they are attached.

Reason: To safeguard the character of the surrounding conservation area.

03. Where permanent trickle ventilation is required, it should be a concealed design.

Reason: To safeguard the character of the listed building and the character of the surrounding conservation area.
