

Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Governance Framework – Proposed changes approved.

4 There was submitted a report by the Chair of the Executive Board regarding proposed changes to the Governance Framework,

- (1) advising that
 - (a) the Glasgow Colleges Regional Board was abolished in July 2025, and that sections 1.4 and 6.3.2 of the framework had been updated to remove this reference and to make reference that individual colleges now had the responsibility to participate in community planning;
 - (b) following the disbandment of the Glasgow Third Sector Interface Network, Glasgow Council for the Voluntary Sector, along with Third Sector organisations in the city, were currently revising the approach to representation on partnership structures and developing a Third Sector Representation Framework, and that the membership at sections 6.3.3, 6.4.3 and 6.5.5 had been updated to reflect the revised approach that would allow and to allow for membership to be updated following their elections that were due to be held later this year;
 - (c) section 6.3.4 had been updated to reflect that Scottish Government Place Directors had been added to the membership of the Strategic Partnership;
 - (d) sections 6.1 and 6.5.6 had been updated to highlight clarification of membership eligibility and co-opted membership eligibility; and
 - (e) the use of Artificial Intelligence systems to produce any form of recording of meetings was detailed at 13.6 as it required approval of the Partnership prior to use; and
- (2) detailing in the Appendix to the report, the updated Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Governance Framework.

After consideration, the Partnership approved the proposed changes to the Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Governance Framework, as detailed in the report.
