

Area Budget 2026/27 – Applications for funding dealt with etc – Declarations of interest.

3 With reference to the minutes of the Council’s City Administration Committee of 12th March 2026, when the committee approved the 2026/27 Area Budget allocations, there was submitted a report by the Head of Policy and Corporate Governance, advising

- (1) of the current position in relation to the Area Partnership’s budget for 2026/27;
- (2) that the Newlands/Auldburn Area Partnership’s Budget allocation for 2026/27 was £68,621; and
- (3) of the applications for funding from the Area Budget for 2026/27.
