

Area Budget 2026/27 – Applications for funding dealt with etc – Declarations of interest.

5 With reference to the minutes of the Council's City Administration Committee of 12th March 2026, when the committee approved the 2026/27 Area Budget allocations, there was submitted a report by the Head of Policy and Corporate Governance, advising

- (1) of the current position in relation to the Area Partnership's budget for 2026/27;
- (2) that the North East Area Partnership's Budget allocation for 2026/27 was £92,293 and that £64,862 had been allocated to date; leaving a balance of £27,431;
- (3) of the 4 applications that had been dealt with under delegated authority, as detailed in the report;
- (4) of the ineligible application that had been received, as detailed in the report; and
- (5) of the applications for funding from the Area Budget for 2026/27.

After consideration, the Partnership
