With new developments increasing there is a need for additional children's play and informal sport space. Request for ENV2 and IPG12 funding to top this up to provide additional play area and landscaping. 10	Barrowland Park is due for a serious upgrade and there are 3 areas that need attention: 1. The album path. This has been degraded over the years and now needs to be repaired to its previous glory. If the artist can be contacted then there should be access to the colours used, the moulds and the manufacturers. Experience might now suggest that stronger materials are used. See photo attached 2. The areas at both sides of the album path. This was surfaced using silver sand, which is considered to have caused damage to the album path when visitors walked on it and then onto the path. The sand should be removed and replaced with a tarmac or similar material 3. The benching supported the slopes on the north and east sides of the park. This is regularly used by the public for seating and works well. However, there is significant rotting of the wood, which needs to be replaced in places.
