Pinkston Water Sports Youth Strategy PRN- 587/23	<u>Proposal:</u> The organisation is seeking funding towards the development of their youth sessions which until this stage has been self-funded but requires external funding to enhance the delivery of youth work within the hub. The organisation anticipates more continuity and stability for young people through the delivery of these sessions especially during winter where there may be a lack of provision due to the change in weather. This project would see a storage container converted to a classroom/learning hub for indoor activity when weather is not suitable to use existing facilities at the water sports centre. The project will be codesigned with the young people who are participating to ensure a willingness to engage with the project and pride in the space they will use due to their involvement in developing the hub. <u>When:</u> October 2026- March 2027 <u>Where:</u> Pinkston Watersports Centre, 75 North Canal Bank Street <u>Who will benefit:</u> 40 young people from the canal ward, drawing on the existing youth forums attendance.
