Minutes of meeting held on 19th May 2026, by video conference.

Minutes of previous meeting – Consideration continued.

1 The Partnership agreed to continue consideration of the minutes of the previous meeting of 14th April 2026 to the next meeting of the Partnership.

Area Budget 2026/27 – Applications for funding dealt with etc.

2 With reference to the minutes of the Council's City Administration Committee of 12th March 2026, when the committee approved the 2026/27 Area Budget allocations, there was submitted a report by the Head of Policy and Corporate Governance, advising

- (1) of the current position in relation to the Area Partnership's budget for 2026/27;
- (2) that the Govan Area Partnership's Budget allocation for 2026/27 was £94,248 and that £61,455 had been allocated to date; leaving a balance of £32,793; and
- (3) of the applications for funding from the Area Budget for 2026/27.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the position regarding the Area Budget allocation for 2026/27; and
- (b) dealt with application for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:
