### Conditions:

1. Suitable provisions should be made for variances in ground conditions.
2. Provide an Event Management Plan
3. Provide a Wind Management Plan
4. A suitable and appropriate system of crowd management will be required to ensure the safe operation of the event and that the maximum capacity figure is not exceeded.
5. Section 89 Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 approval for any structure 600mm and greater above ground level is required.

### Background Information:

It is proposed to hold a community event around the Commonwealth Games from 23<sup>rd</sup> July to the 2<sup>nd</sup> August between 10am and 10:45pm.

The event will consist of Stage, screens, sports activation areas, food units and a bar.

The capacity of the event is 10,000 persons
