## **1. Introduction**

- 1.1 To facilitate a co-ordinated work programme for the revised Glasgow Community Planning Partnership (GCPP) structures, draft work plans are being developed for all levels of the CPP structures.

- 2.4 It was noted that all work plans should flow from the remits that have been agreed for the various structures. These are outlined in the Governance Framework for GCPP. Two key aspects of the remit of Area Partnerships are with regard to Neighbourhood Management and Community Engagement and these were highlighted at the meeting.
