

## **Road safety inspection and repair policy approved.**

**4** With reference to the minutes of the Environment, Sustainability and Carbon Reduction City Policy Committee of 19th March 2019 (Print 7, page 539) when it had been agreed to recommend to this committee approval of a revised road safety inspection and repair policy, Councillor Anna Richardson, City Convener for Sustainability and Carbon Reduction, presented a report on the proposed policy, advising

- (1) that the new policy specifically related to a risk based procedure for conducting road safety inspections, which was the area of service that resulted in the Council's greatest number of claims;
- (2) of the key aspects and the implementation of the proposed policy; and
- (3) that an effective public engagement and communication strategy would be required to promote the new policy, which would highlight key benefits and highlight how it would represent better value than existing arrangements.

After consideration, the committee approved the road safety inspection and repair policy, as detailed in the report.
