

Domestic glass collection service – Update noted.

3 With reference to the minutes of 9th October 2018 (Print 4, page 288) instructing the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods and Sustainability to submit to a future meeting a report on glass recycling, there was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods and Sustainability regarding the domestic glass collection service, advising

- (1) that the domestic glass collection contract had been provided by Viridor and had commenced in June 2011 for a period of 5 years plus 2 years and had been further extended to 31st March 2019;
- (2) of the current collection service arrangements, the service costs and the tonnages collected from the kerbside collection service and from the public collection point network over the last 5 years, as detailed in the table in the report;
- (3) that the service had been subject to a procurement process however, following an internal review comparing external costs of delivery to an in-house service, the decision was made to bring the service in-house and the tender process terminated; and
- (4) that there would be a review of service delivery which would take into account the current collection model where kerbside collection and public site service depended on the property type and the collection frequencies for both kerbside and public sites, following which a further report would be brought back to the committee for consideration.
