

Joint health protection plan 2018-20 noted.

6 There was submitted and noted report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods and Sustainability regarding the NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde Joint Health Protection Plan 2018-20, advising

- (1) that the Public Health Etc (Scotland) Act 2008 required NHS Boards, in consultation with Local Authorities, to produce a Joint Health Protection Plan, which would provide an overview of health protection (communicable disease and environmental health) priorities, provision and preparedness for the NHS Board area;
- (2) that the Public Health Protection Unit at NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde had produced the NHS GG&C Joint Health Protection Plan 2018-20 in partnership with the relevant local authorities;
- (3) that the plan set out the partnership commitments of each signatory organisation with regard to the protection of the public from risk and disease in line with the NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde Strategy;
- (4) of the Joint Health Protection Plan (JHPP) which covered the period from 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2020, as detailed at Appendix A of the report;
- (5) that the supporting JHPP guidance, published by the Scottish Government, stated that each signatory local authority should have the plan signed off by an appropriate Council committee;
- (6) of the overarching aim and implementation of the plan; and
- (7) that Neighbourhoods and Sustainability had structures in place to deliver the Council's obligations under the Act and it was intended that the next iteration of the plan would be presented to committee for consideration in 2020.
