

20mph zones – Policy approved.

7 With reference to the minutes of the Environment, Sustainability and Carbon Reduction City Policy Committee of 26th November 2019 (Print 5, page 366) when it had been agreed to recommend to this committee approval of the policy for the introduction of city-wide 20mph restrictions in Glasgow, subject to funds being available, Councillor Richardson, City Convener for Sustainability and Carbon Reduction, presented a report regarding the proposed policy, advising

- (1) of the Glasgow Health Commission's recommendations in June 2009 regarding the introduction of 20mph zones and of the evidence of the benefits of 20mph speed limits becoming more compelling, with several cities in the UK having introduced widespread 20mph speed limits; and
- (2) of the proposed policy for the introduction of city-wide 20mph restrictions in Glasgow.

After consideration, the committee approved the new policy for implementing city-wide 20mph restrictions in Glasgow, subject to funds being available.
