

River Clyde Corridor and Govan-Partick (Wards 5 and 8 to 13) Strategic Development Frameworks approved.

3 With reference to the minutes of the Neighbourhoods, Housing and Public Realm City Policy Committee of 19th November 2019 (Print 5, page 362) when it had been agreed to recommend to this committee approval of the River Clyde Corridor and Govan-Partick (Wards 5 and 8 to 13) Strategic Development Frameworks (SDF), Councillor McLean, City Convener for Neighbourhoods, Housing and Public Realm, presented a report regarding the matter, advising

- (1) of the outcomes of the public consultation exercises for the River Clyde Corridor and the Govan-Partick SDFs, which had ran for 8 weeks from December 2018 until February 2019, with representations received on each SDF being recorded and summarised in a table which included the Council's response to each comment and explained whether this had resulted in any change to the relevant SDF; and
- (2) that the modified version of each SDF represented the final version that was proposed for submission to the Scottish Government for scrutiny.

After consideration, the committee approved the adoption of the River Clyde Corridor SDF and Govan-Partick SDF as supplementary guidance to the City Development Plan and its submission to the Scottish Government.
