

Transforming Pollok Country Park - Update noted.

4 There was submitted a report by the Chief Executive of Glasgow Life, regarding the transforming Pollok Country Park project and of the current progress and engagement activities, advising

- (1) of the aims and objectives of the project;
- (2) that Glasgow City Council and Glasgow Life had been engaging with the public and other stakeholders regarding the Pollok Country Park transformation project and its proposals to modify the private car access and vehicular routes, changing car parking arrangements, improving accessibility and promoting public transport and pedestrian links; and
- (3) of the proposals for formal consultation, which would specifically focus on the emerging access proposals and would be followed by the submission of a planning application to the Council.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report; and
- (b) raised concerns regarding the undernoted issues, which were answered by A Fleming Knox and I Shire during the meeting:-
 - (i) a proposed drop-off point and parking for coaches and coach trip parties; and
 - (ii) how Glasgow Life had contacted local groups and bus companies to discuss public access to bicycle hire within the park and bus routes close to the entrance.
