

## **Full Business Cases approved by Chief Executives' Group noted.**

**11** With reference to the minutes of 11th October 2017 agreeing a revision to the Assurance Framework in relation to the approvals required for business cases, there was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Regional Economic Growth advising that the Chief Executives' Group had approved, under delegated authority, the Full Business Cases and funding requirements for the undernoted Glasgow City Council Infrastructure projects:-

- (1) Clyde Waterfront & West End Innovation Quarter – Central Govan Action Plan – Public Realm (Phases 1 and 2) - £0.673m;
- (2) Canal and North Gateway – FBC 3 – Sighthill: Cowlairs Bridge; Port Dundas; and 100 Acre Hill - £10.8m;
- (3) Canal and North Gateway – FBC 4 – North Glasgow Integrated Water Management System - £4.386m; and
- (4) City Centre Enabling Infrastructure Integrated Public Realm – Intelligent Street Lighting - £1.662m.
