

Area Partnership Budget 2017/18 - Applications for funding dealt with etc.

7 With reference to the minutes of the Council's Executive Committee of 1st June 2017 approving an allocation of £60,351 to the Calton Area Budget 2017/18, there was submitted a report by the Director of Governance and Solicitor to the Council advising of the current position in relation to the Calton Area Budget 2017/18 and detailing a number of applications for funding.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (1) noted that to date £55,459 had been allocated to various projects in the Calton Ward;
- (2) dealt with the applications for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:-
