

NORTH EAST SECTOR COMMUNITY PLANNING PARTNERSHIP.

Minutes of meeting held on 29th August 2018 at the City Chambers, Glasgow.

Appointment of substitute Chair noted.

1 The Partnership noted that in terms of 7.4 of the Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Governance Framework, Councillor Hepburn had nominated Councillor Morgan to act as Chair in his absence.

Valediction.

2 Councillor Morgan advised that George McGuinness MBE was retiring from his role on Baillieston Community Council and from membership of this Partnership and thanked him for his contribution to the work of the Partnership.

Minutes of the previous meeting approved.

3 There was submitted and approved the minutes of 8th June 2018.

Minutes of the Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Strategic Board noted.

4 The minutes of the Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Strategic Board of 12th June 2018 were submitted and noted.

Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Governance Framework – Membership update noted etc.

5 There was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Governance and Solicitor to the Council providing an update on the membership of this Partnership, advising

- (1) that Alena Alex had resigned from Shettleston Area Partnership creating a vacancy on this Sector Partnership, and that Jimmy Reilly had been nominated as representative which left the substitute representative vacant;
- (2) that Alan MacIntyre was no longer the substitute representative from Police Scotland, and had been replaced by Inspector Andy Small;
- (3) that Margaret McQuade was now the representative from North East Area partnership; and
- (4) of the current membership of this Partnership, as detailed in the report.

Victim Support – Update noted.

6 There was heard and noted a verbal report from Ann Marie Adair, Service Delivery Officer, Victim Support Glasgow regarding the service and support, in the north east of the city, offered to clients who were victims of crime.

Transition Programmes update noted.

7 With reference to the minutes of 7th February 2018 identifying that care for children was an issue affecting the north east of the city, there was submitted and noted a report by the Principal of Glasgow Kelvin College regarding the College's transitions programmes for care experienced young people, advising

- (1) that the College transitions programmes were an important aspect of its Access and Inclusion strategy, which focussed resources for young people at significant disadvantage;
- (2) of the various programmes delivered by the College which formed their transitions programmes as detailed in the report; and
- (3) of the outcomes achieved during 2017/18 for young people enrolled on the transitions programmes.

School leaver destinationreturn 2016/17 and destinations of care leavers - Update noted – Request to Assistant Chief Officer, Children's Services, Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership.

8 With reference to the minutes of 7th February 2018 identifying that care for children was an issue affecting the north east of the city, there was submitted a report by the Assistant Chief Officer, Children's Services, Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership regarding Glasgow's School Leaver Destination Return 2016/17 and the destination of care-leavers, advising

- (1) of the range of support provided to help Glasgow's care experienced young people; and
- (2) on the performance in assisting them to achieve positive destinations.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (a) noted the report;
- (b) acknowledged that the Partnership needed to be more proactive in changing the lives of care experienced young people, and that evidence showing that in keeping a young care experienced person in the community was more beneficial than being taken outwith, be provided when available; and
- (c) requested more information on
 - (i) the number of care experienced young people sustaining supported tenancies; and
 - (ii) the corporate parenting role which supported care experienced young people into university and college.

Updated work plan noted.

9 With reference to the minutes of 7th February 2018 identifying local issues affecting the north east of the city which this Partnership could influence in order to make improvements and that these issues would be built into future meeting agendas, there was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities detailing an amended work plan which included some of the issues identified.

Fire at Stobhill Hospital – Update noted – Request to Scottish Fire and Rescue Service.

10 The Partnership, as a matter of urgency, agreed to consider as an additional item a verbal update from Scottish Fire and Rescue on the fire at the old Stobhill Hospital on 31st July 2018.

After discussion, the Partnership

- (1) conveyed the Partnership's full support to Scottish Fire & Rescue Service in its negotiations with NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde for the demolition of the decommissioned building; and
- (2) requested Scottish Fire & Rescue Service to bring an update on the wider scale of the work they do with site owners of decommissioned buildings in order to ensure the building was safe and secure.
