

Glasgow City Integration Joint Board Strategic Plan 2019-22 – Consultation arrangements noted – Action agreed etc.

2 There was submitted a report by the Chief Officer, Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership regarding the draft Glasgow City Integration Joint Board (IJB) Strategic Plan 2019-22, advising that

- (1) strategic planning for social care and community health services within Glasgow was delegated to the Glasgow City IJB in accordance with the provisions of the Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Scotland) Act 2014 and the Integration Scheme agreed by this Council and NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde;
- (2) the IJB was statutorily required to produce a Strategic Plan, covering a maximum period of 3 years, which outlined how the 9 National Health and Wellbeing Outcomes would be achieved; and
- (3) the consultation period would run until mid-January 2019, following which all feedback received during the consultation period would be analysed, and a final draft plan presented for consideration to the IJB in March 2019.

After consideration, the committee agreed that Councillor Andrew convene a small cross party group of members from this committee to prepare its formal response to the IJB on the draft Glasgow City IJB Strategic Plan for 2019-22.
