Strategic Plan Performance - Grand Challenge 3 - Fight the climate emergency in just transition to a net zero Glasgow, Missions 1 and 2 - Service commitments noted.

1 With reference to the minutes of 16th November 2022 (Print 4, page 414) noting a performance toolkit that would capture the actions and underpin the Grand Challenges and Missions contained within the Council's Strategic Plan 2022-27, there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the commitments that would fight the climate emergency in just transition to a net zero Glasgow,

- (1) advising that services had been requested to report on areas within the Strategic Plan with a wider lens than the Cost of Living focus and to now reflect on the wider commitments within the Plan, whilst keeping track of commitments that emerged through the Cost of Living lens; and
- (2) detailing in an appendix to the report
 - (a) the progress made on previously reported Cost of Living commitments relating to Grand Challenge 3 - Fight the climate emergency in just transition to a net zero Glasgow;
 - (b) newly incorporated commitments and the work currently underway to support those commitments across key areas that had a particular focus on Grand Challenge 3 - Mission 1: Deliver sustainable transport and travel aligned with the city region and Mission 2: Become a net zero carbon city by 2030; and

- (c) an update on Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability's Carbon Management Plan that had been subject to an Internal Audit Review.

After consideration, the committee noted the Grand Challenges, Missions and Commitments within the Strategic Plan in respect of Grand Challenge 3 - Missions 1 and 2.
