Glasgow Violence Against Women Partnership – Update noted.

- There was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding an update on the work of the Glasgow Violence Against Women Partnership (GVAWP), advising
- (1) that the production of the GVAWP city wide Glasgow Strategic Plan (GSP) remained in draft format and that the Scottish Government and COSLA had now produced a refresh of the Equally Safe Delivery Plan on 13th August 2024, which would accompany and align to the GSP, with the final draft being presented to committee in November 2024;
- of the current GVAMP activity and the range of work and projects that had been supported as a response to the pandemic and which had continued in recognition of the impact of the cost-of-living crisis on those experiencing violence against women;
- (3) of updates on the WAIR Group (Women, Asylum Immigration & Refugees) working group, the Women, Destitutuion and No Recourse to Public Funds project and the Glasgow Multi-agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC) Steering Group; and
- (4) that Glasgow City Health and Social Care Partnership, Governance Board had requested a practice audit to be undertaken to consider if there would be means to reduce the volume of referrals safely and robustly to Glasgow MARAC.
