Gaelic Medium Education 2024 – Update noted etc.

- 1 With reference to the minutes of 22nd April 2021 (Print 1, page 32) requesting further updates on Gaelic Medium Education (GME), there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Education Services, advising of the
- (1) Council's GME provision along with the number of pupils enrolled in each of the establishments and the current capacity;
- (2) current staffing position and that probationers across both primary and secondary schools continued to be supported;
