1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Council meeting of 28th March 2024 approved a motion regarding the conflict in Gaza. This included a request for the City Administration Committee to consider a request for a financial donation to the UK based charity Medical Aid for Palestine.
- 1.2 The Council is not authorised to provide direct relief to communities abroad, however it is able to make donations to UK based charities. At the City Administration Committee of 10th March 2022 a donation of £20,000 was approved to be made to the Disasters Emergencies Committee to fund its member charities' UK-based activities, in recognition of the considerable strain the crisis in Ukraine is placing on the resources of these charities.
- 1.3 It is proposed that a donation of the same value is made to the UK based charity of Medical Aid for Palestine. They are currently running an emergency appeal to support the provision of medical supplies, emergency food and humanitarian aid in Gaza.
