

Annual Planning Performance Framework 2022/23 noted.

4 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding an annual Planning Performance Framework (PPF) 2022/23, advising

- (1) that the 12th PPF produced by this Council covering the period from 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023, and had been prepared as an ArcGIS storymap which provided a report on the Council's planning performance over the year and was supported by evidence and case studies that demonstrated wider qualitative outcomes, along with measured information on key aspects of work including the City Development Plan, Development Management and Enforcement;
- (2) of the Scottish Government feedback for this Council's PPF for 2022/23; and
- (3) that the action plan, as detailed in the report, had identified 12 green markers, 1 amber and 1 red rated performance marker.

After consideration, the committee noted

- (a) the annual Planning Performance Framework 2022/23;
- (b) the performance of the Planning Service and the feedback from the Scottish Government for the reporting year;
- (c) that the Planning Service enabled the delivery of sustainable, liveable and productive places and was committed to continuous improvement; and
- (d) that information regarding the Council's response to the Call for Ideas would be circulated to members.
