#### Infrastructure Grant Allocations 2023/24

## **Purpose of Report:**

This report advises the Cabinet of the proposed allocation of the Infrastructure Grant to each Member Authority for 2023/24.

#### 1. Purpose

1.1 This report advises the Cabinet of the proposed allocation of Infrastructure Grant to each Member Authority for 2023/24.

# 2. Background

- 2.1 As a result of prior year accelerated grant funding increasing the grant award for the years 2020/21 and 2021/22, the 2023/24 grant was much smaller than usual as agreed with the Scottish Government at £15m. This smaller grant rendered an interim allocation unsound as it could have distorted the allocations over the full year and the allocation was, therefore, based on the full year financials from the Q4 Project Status Reports.
- 2.2 The approach in relation to the allocation of grant in 2023/24 is based on each Member Authority's cumulative actual spend levels reported in the Quarter 4 Project Status Reports. This approach is consistent with that for prior year main grant allocations considered by the Cabinet.
- 2.3 Grant funds allocated to member authorities cannot be in excess of eligible expenditure incurred and the proposed final infrastructure grant allocations for 2023/24, together with expenditure incurred, grants received to date and grant ceiling, are shown in the table below.
